Re: Seats open for the city's general election to be held on November 7, 2017

To whom it may be of interest:

The following will be open seats up for election this year in the City of Meriden. The mayoral term limit is two years and council term limits are four years:


Three City Council Seats (Jan 2018-Jan 2022)  
Mayor's Seat (Jan 2018-Jan 2020)

The deadline to file for the above positions is noon on **June 1, 2017**. If a **primary election** is required, it will be held **August 1, 2017**. The **general election** will be held on **November 7, 2017**.

In November 2019, the mayor's seat and two council seats will be up for election. Those term limits would begin the second Monday in January 2020 and end in 2024, to allow for staggered terms for council positions.

If you are interested in running for office, you will need to either file a declaration of candidacy accompanied by the required fee (Year 2017, the filing fee is twenty dollars), or a nomination petition nominating another individual along with signatures of five qualified electors of the City of Meriden. This all will take place at the Jefferson County Clerk's office in Oskaloosa, Kansas, located within the courthouse.
